Rules and Regulations

Matches

Matches must be played on lined pitches of good condition and size with use of nets and flags. Changing and toilet facilities should be provided.

All matches are of 30 minute-a-side duration with a break at half time.

Match Result and Scores must be texted to the co-ordinator on the day of the match. Please fax/send a match report, with referees signature to the co-ordinator.

Home team must contact Away team to arrange fixture.

Home team arranges referee, if possible. If not, Away team must be given adequate notice to do so.

If a play-off is deemed necessary within a group, the committee will contact the appropriate teams

There will be a draw for home venues of semi-finals.

Gear

All teams must be togged out with **numbered jerseys and camogie skirts/skorts**.

Helmets are compulsory. **Shin-guards** are highly recommended. **Protective tape** must be used to cover any exposed metal on the hurleys.

Referees

Referees must be qualified for all Junior and Senior matches.

Home Team pays referee's fees - **€40 for single matches**

For Semi-Finals, a referee from the official list must be used but should have no affiliation to your school or local clubs.

The Team Manager/Mentor is responsible for the correct behaviour of all players and supporters.

Any school playing an illegal or unregistered player will be expelled from all competitions.

The decision of the committee is final.
